

Veterinary Technician

The Veterinary Technician position operates in the main hospital and manages appointments, urgent care, general practice surgery, and high volume spay/neuter surgery. The Technician works closely with Veterinary Assistants and Veterinarians to provide quality care to clients of all backgrounds. As the only only full-service nonprofit veterinary hospital in the Midwest, Mission serves primarily low-income pet owners. The Technician position is aligned with Mission's goal: to work hard every day to help sick pets and educate owners so that pets and families can stay together.

Job Details:

- Full-time, non-exempt (hourly), benefits-eligible
- Schedule may be either:
 - o 3, 13-hour shifts/week, including 2 weekends every 6 weeks
 - 4, 10-hour shifts/week, including 2 weekends every 6 weeks
- Benefits: health insurance, 401(k), pet care discount, professional development

Responsibilities:

This person will work closely with all of our services (appointments, urgent care, and surgery) and provide valuable support to veterinarians. Duties may include:

- General patient monitoring and care
- Performing diagnostic tests and x-rays
- Preparing animals and instruments for surgery
- Administering medications, vaccines, and treatments
- Observing and reporting on the behavior and condition of animals
- Restraining animals for examination or treatment
- Administering anesthesia and assisting during medical procedures
- Collecting and recording animal case histories
- Assisting with discharges and client communication

Qualifications:

- Certified Veterinary Technician or equivalent experience
- Developed communication skills, professionalism, and ability to collaborate with a team
- Commitment to hospital core values of compassionate, accessible care

Professional Development:

- Formalized and personalized on-boarding program, focusing in each service area
- Technician Skill Levels 1, 2, and 3; raises after passing each level
- Leadership opportunities as they become available in inventory, training, safety, rescue partnership, operations, and more
